Intro: Theology of Salvation

All are sinners—No one is righteous

No one is right before God—Depravity of man

God is just in declaring all people guilty as charged, judgment is eternal damnation.

Man is made right before God—God credits or imputes the righteousness of Christ through faith in Christ.

Man is justified—Acquitted of all charges of sin through the redemption of Christ through faith.

God is the justifier

Salvation is by grace, through faith, a gift of God
